¹ Prof. Dr.hc. Raimund Beckmann (*1938 in Osnabrück) was called in as architect to adapt the design of the Art Academy by competition winner Günther Domenig (*1934 in Klagenfurt; † June 15, 2012 in Graz). In addition to taking into account the wishes of the academy to reduce the costs, R. Beckmann tried to develop a new design while retaining the urban planning specifications of G. Domenig. He succeeded in reducing the cost estimate from approx. 40 million DM to approx. 29 million DM. Costs of around DM 20 million were originally planned for financing.

² R. Beckmann was injured in a skiing accident a few days before the above-mentioned day, which resulted in his dependence on a wheelchair.

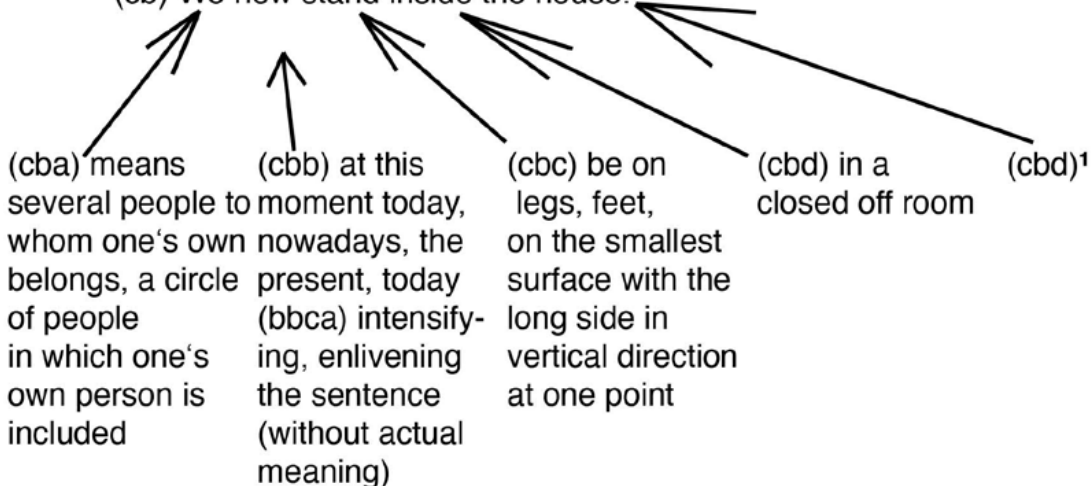
- (a) A house¹ is a building².

¹ A house is a “permanent building consisting of an shell and supporting structure; developed from the shelter of prehistoric times to the present diverse types of buildings. Geograph., climat. conditions, building materials, technology, living requirements and the ruling social order determine the function, form and type of construction.” A house is generally described as a building if its primary purpose is to serve as regular accommodation for people, especially for living, working or for meetings. In addition to the purpose described above, typical but not always obligatory features of a house are

- the existence of numerous windows (as distinct from, for example, bunkers, barns),
- Room heights that do not exceed ca. 4 meters (in contrast to halls, cinemas, theater buildings, for example)
- a certain quality and durability (as opposed to huts, barracks, containers or provisional shelters, for example).

² A building is a structure that contains rooms, can be entered and is used for the residence of people, animals or the storage of things. A building is a container specially constructed by humans through intentional action, with the rational use of the means at their disposal (building materials, building tools, etc.), for the purpose of constructing an interior that has a space or spaces and in particular serves the idea of functionally separating its contents (dwellings, storage, stables, etc.) from its environment (surroundings). A building does not necessarily have walls or a basement, but it always has a roof. Otherwise, the characteristics of a structure also apply to a building. Some definitions define the term more narrowly and restrict it to structures that rise above the ground. There are free-standing buildings (detached houses) as well as semi-detached houses and groups of houses.

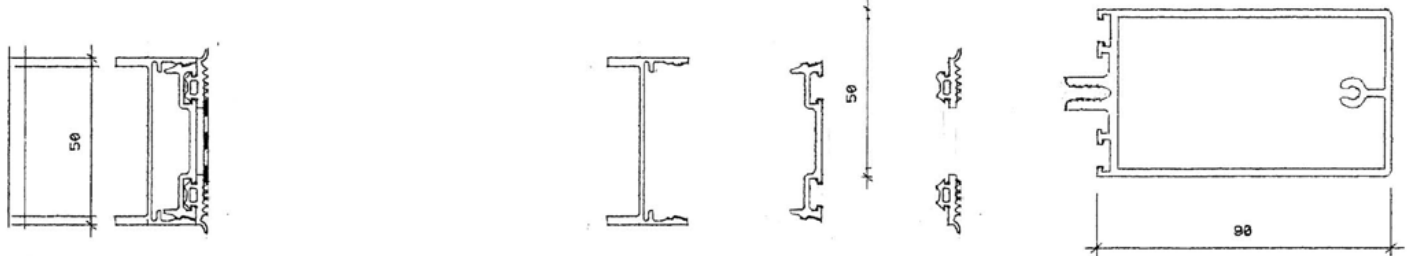
³ For example: air, animals, people, (rain)water, snow, dirt, leaves, fire

⁴ In the construction industry, a window is a light opening in a wall or roof of a building and its wind and weatherproof closure. Windows provide light, ventilation and a view in and out. Windows are also one of the main aesthetic elements of the facade structure⁵ of the facade. In a figurative sense, a window can also refer to a temporary opening in a (often abstract) medium.

⁶ Condensation water (also known as sweating water or dew water) is the water that gathers on a cool surface of objects as soon as air containing water vapor is cooled below the dew point. The formation of water (condensation) on surfaces in open spaces is also known as dew or condensation. Undesirable:

- Condensation on the inside or in the component of building walls with poor thermal insulation
- Condensation on the window in the edge area of the glass strip (the glass edge seal)
